

<b>Crop(s)</b>	<b>Pulse crops</b>
<b>Disease(s)</b>	<b>Grey mould (<i>Botrytis</i>) and ascochyta</b>

Resistance management strategy for:

<b>Group 1</b>	Methyl benzimidazole carbamates;
<b>Group 2</b>	Dicarboximide;
<b>Group 3 + 11</b>	Demethylation inhibitors (DMI) + Quinone outside inhibitor (QoI);
<b>Group 7*</b>	Succinate dehydrogenase inhibitors (SDHI);
<b>Group 7 + 3</b>	SDHI + DMI; and
<b>Group 7 + 12</b>	SDHI + phenylpyrroles (PP).

\* Currently only available under temporary permit. Always check that permits are valid prior to use.

## Guidelines

1. Not all listed products are registered for both diseases. Ensure the product is registered for the disease being targeted
2. **Do not** apply more than two **Group 1, 2, 3+11, 7+3** or **7+12** sprays in one season (including seed treatment).
3. **Do not** apply more than two consecutive **Group 1, 2** or **7** sprays, including from season to season and seed treatments. The final foliar spray of the previous season should be considered when planning which fungicide group to use in seed treatments and the first foliar application. **Group 7** containing sprays should not make up more than one in every three of the spray program.
4. If a **Group 7** containing fungicide is used as a seed treatment, the first foliar fungicide used must not contain a **Group 7** fungicide.
